

NOTICE OF ELECTION SENEDD ELECTION CLWYD CONSTITUENCY

1. An election is to be held for Members to serve in the Senedd for the Clwyd constituency
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Constituency Returning Officer, Tŷ Dewi Sant, St. David's Park, Ewloe, Flintshire CH5 3FF or electronically via candidates@flintshire.gov.uk
3. Nomination Papers may be delivered by prior appointment to the Constituency Returning Officer at Tŷ Dewi Sant, St. David's Park, Ewloe, Flintshire CH5 3FF between the hours of **9am and 4pm** on any working day (Monday to Friday) from the date of publication of this notice but not later than **4pm on Thursday 9 April 2026** or electronically as per the arrangements set out in the electronic delivery statement below but not later than **4pm on Thursday 9 April 2026**.
4. The deposit of £500 per individual candidate or the deposit of £500 for the first candidate on a party list, and £200 for each of the next five candidates on the party list, can be paid either in cash, bankers draft (banks operating in the United Kingdom only) or by direct bank transfer.
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 7 May 2026**.
6. Applications to be added to the Register of Electors in order to vote at this election must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **Monday 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. Applications, amendments, or cancellations of postal votes must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Tuesday 21 April 2026**.
8. Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work / service reasons must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Thursday 7 May 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work / service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
10. Nomination papers submitted electronically must be delivered in accordance with the arrangements set out in this statement.

- An electronic read receipt from the Constituency Returning Officer is not confirmation that the nomination is valid. The Constituency Returning Officer will send a notice of their decision as to whether or not a nomination is valid.
