

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Senedd Election Fflint Wrexham Constituency

1. An election is to be held for Members to serve in the Senedd for the Fflint Wrexham constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Constituency Returning Officer, Guildhall, Wrexham, LL11 1AY or electronically via seneddelection@wrexham.gov.uk.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered, by prior appointment, to the Constituency Returning Officer at Guildhall, Wrexham, LL11 1AY between the hours of **9am and 4pm** on any working day (Monday to Friday) from the date of publication of this notice but not later than 4pm on Thursday 9 April 2026 or electronically as per the arrangements set out in the electronic delivery statement below but not later than 4pm on Thursday 9 April 2026.
4. The deposit of £500 per individual candidate or the deposit of £500 for the first candidate on a party list, and £200 for each of the next five candidates on the party list, can be paid either in cash, banker's draft (banks operating in the United Kingdom only) or by direct bank transfer.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 7 May 2026**.
6. Applications to be added to the Register of Electors in order to vote at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 12 midnight on **Monday 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by **5pm on Tuesday 21 April 2026**.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by **5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work / service reasons must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Thursday 7 May 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work / service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026**.

10. Electronic delivery statement

- Nomination papers submitted electronically, by email, must be delivered in accordance with arrangements set out in this statement.

- **Informal checks** – please enter ‘**INFORMAL CHECK**’ in the subject heading
- **Submitting nominations** – please enter ‘**FORMAL SUBMISSION**’ in the subject heading
- The above email address may also be used for nomination queries.
- Where possible, please include your telephone contact details in the covering email in case of queries.
- Nomination papers should be attached to the email in either a Word or PDF format. A typed signature, electronic signature or a wet ink signature (on a scanned nomination paper) are all valid signature types for nomination papers delivered electronically.

Please note:

- It is the responsibility of the Nomination Officer for a party or individual candidates, as appropriate, to ensure that the Constituency Returning Officer receives nomination forms in the correct way by the required deadlines.
- An electronic read receipt from the Constituency Returning Officer is not confirmation that the nomination is valid. The Constituency Returning Officer will send a notice of their decision as to whether or not a nomination is valid. However, you should receive an automatic response from the email address shown above, which will indicate that an email has been received. If you do not receive an automatic response, please contact electoral@wrexham.gov.uk.
