

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Senedd Election

For the Bangor Conwy Môn Constituency

1. An election is to be held for Members to serve in the Senedd for the Bangor Conwy Môn constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Returning Officer, at Coed Pella, Conway Road, Colwyn Bay, Conwy, LL29 7AZ, or electronically via electoral@conwy.gov during the times states below.
3. Nomination papers may be delivered to the Returning Officer at Coed Pella, Conway Road, Colwyn Bay, Conwy, LL29 7AZ between 9am and 5pm on any working day from the date of publication of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but not later than 4pm on Thursday, 9 April 2026 or electronically as per the arrangements set out in the electronic delivery statement below.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 7 May 2026**.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **Monday, 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
6. The deposit of £500 per individual candidate or the deposit of £500 for the first candidate on a party list, and £200 for each of the next five candidates on the party list, can be paid by legal tender, banker's draft (from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom) or by direct bank transfer.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday, 21 April 2026.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday, 28 April 2026.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer 5pm on Thursday, 7 May 2026.

9. Electronic delivery statement

Nomination papers submitted electronically must be delivered in accordance with arrangements set out in this statement.

- **Informal checks** - by email to electoral@conwy.gov.uk – please enter ‘INFORMAL CHECK – SENEDDBCM26’ in the subject heading.
- **Submitting nominations** - visit www.conwy.gov.uk/nominations and submit the nomination paper using the online portal.

Please note:

- It is the responsibility of Nominating Officer for a party or individual candidates as appropriate to ensure that the Returning Officer receives nomination forms in the correct way by the required deadlines.
- An electronic read receipt from the Returning Officer is not confirmation that the nomination is valid. The Returning Officer will send a notice of their decision as to whether or not a nomination is valid.
